Muddy Bottom

Description: Muddy Bottom is a well-known off-roading site situated near the M27 junction 1. It is a large site over 100 acres with a wide variety of off-roading challenges.

Off-Roading: The site comprises of all aspects of off-roading from bomb hole wood, river & ford crossings, clay holes, steep hills, treacherous bog areas, axle twisting obstacles, wooden step section.

Facilities: Mains water is available so the club jet wash can be used to clean vehicles before returning to the public roads. Camping is available on site on the Saturday night @ £10 per caravan or tent – please contact the club to arrange this. 07773125745

Upon entering you will find toilet facilities to your right, along with spectator parking and kiosk. On your left will be the catering trailer and picnic area so families with young children can sit under the trees, and have a bite to eat. This area is cordoned off to make it safer for the children to play.

Directions: From M27 motorway, come off at junction 1, head for Lyndhurst (A337). At Cadnam roundabout turn right heading for Lyndhurst. Ignore the first two right turnings signposted Minstead, but take 3rd turning on your right (look for club signs) go over the cattle grid, the road narrows to a single lane, then take the 2nd gravel track on the right signposted (Mill house), bear left to Muddy Bottom 4x4's main entrance.
